

IPSWICH TRANSPORT AND MODEL FESTIVAL

Event runs 1000 - 1630 approx on Saturday 28th June 2014

Admission - to all sites; inclusive tickets Adults/Concessions £9.50, accompanied Children £1.

If you want to attend just one site (eg the transport museum) normal admission charges for the site apply.

Limited car parking available around the transport museum and model engineering society.

Why not use public transport - our free bus service connects at Derby Road station and with local buses at Ipswich Hospital, including Ipswich Park and Ride (inbound layby in Woodbridge Road).

The Ipswich Transport Museum, the Ipswich Railway Modellers Association and the Ipswich Model Engineering Society have teamed up once again to provide a coordinated event at our three sites, linked together by a vintage bus service provided from the operational fleet of the Ipswich Transport Museum, Suffolk Bus Preservation Group and Ipswich Bus Preservation Group.

The day is designed to showcase the best in local model railways, model engineering and transport preservation, with active support and sponsorship from our SCOGRAIL. IPSWICH TRANSPORT MUSEUM

(alight at Museum bus stop) Refreshments on Site Accessible WC

- There are over 100 major transport and engineering exhibits on display at the Transport Museum. There will be additional model displays including:
- **G Scale trains** Constructed by one of the ITM Volunteers, Tony White. Mostly LGB models (1:22.5 scale, or thereabouts) normally used on garden railways. The track gauge of 45mm is the same as that used by Gauge 1 model railways.
- **The Ipswich Branch of the Hornby Railway Collectors' Association** - displays from Harold Landin with O Gauge electric and clockwork Hornby and a 2-rail electric OO Gauge layout with Hornby and modern stock, and a 3-rail Hornby Dublo layout from John Smith, featuring BR liveried stock in tinfoil from the 1950's
- **Meccano** the well known constructional toy invented in 1901 in England by Frank Hornby and manufactured between 1908 and 1980. Assembled and working models from Ron Frith.
- **The Ipswich Bus Preservation Group** are expected to display their 1987 Leyland Olympian D261 FYL, which was new to London Buses. It should be used on today's bus service.
- **Model Bus Federation**—display of model buses arranged by Norman Dickerson
- **Large Scale 1/24 model trucks** - an impressive display of radio control models by Harry Wahlandt and Andy Smith
- **Model Trolley Buses**— a sales stand including a metre long model trolleybus from Ashley Bruce.
